In each of these positions, there are biomechanical and tissue requirements for the patient's body positioning to be appropriately useful to the patient. For instance, prone position surgeries, that is surgeries where the patient is positioned to lie face down on the operating table, comes with mats in the chest and pelvis; this makes it easier to reduce pressure on the back and articulations. In the same way, lithotomy positions (as applied in gynecological and urological surgeries) demand mats that should accommodate legs and avoid nerve injury.

Lateral position gel pads are usually incorporated into the OT table mats, and offer the required side support for the particular surgeries where the patient is to remain in a lateral position. These pads assist in retaining the normal alignment of the body especially in spinal, thoracic and hip surgery. Without such support, the patient may change position, which is a potential danger in such a condition.

Although various surgeries do not require long time and complicated positions for the patient and the surgeon, every operation is better to use the OT table mat. It also becomes evident that even brief surgeries are dangerous to patients who are on hard or inadequately padded surfaces. OT table mats with <u>silicon gel pads</u> help avoid pressure points and awkward positions, so they are justified for every procedure.
